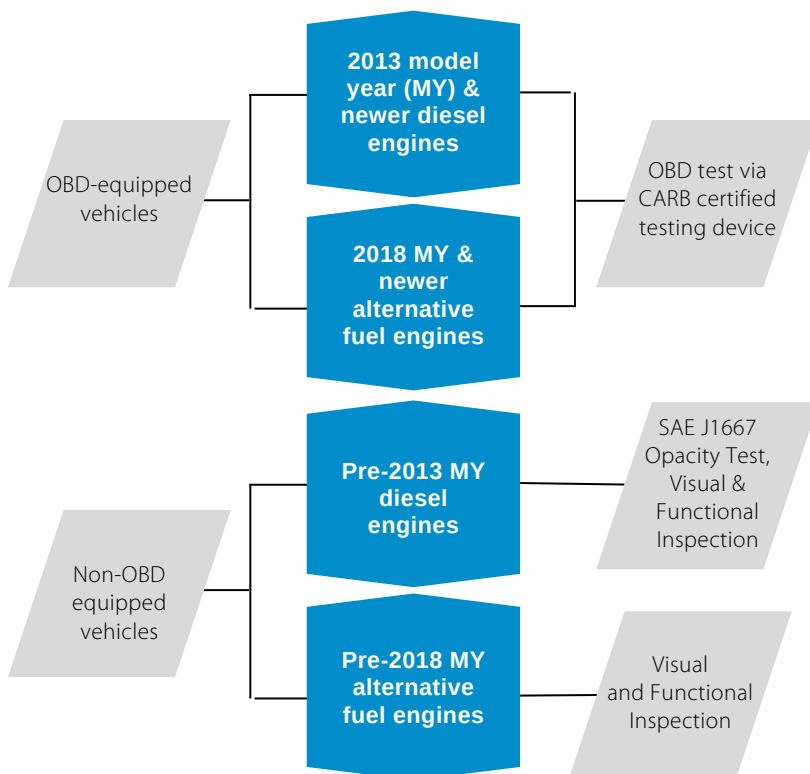

Emissions Test Requirements



Notice To Submit Testing (NST)

Since January 2023, California has deployed roadside emissions monitoring equipment across the state to identify vehicles emitting high levels of pollutants. If your vehicle is flagged as a potential high emitter, you will receive an NST letter, providing a 30-day window to submit a successful emissions test to CARB. Non-compliance will lead to violations, the revocation of compliance certification, and a hold on DMV registration.

Testing Frequency

OBD-equipped vehicles: 2 times per year, increasing to 4 times per year after 3 years.
Non-OBD equipped vehicles: 2 times per year.
Agricultural vehicles and California-registered motorhomes: Once per year.

Requirements

The Clean Truck Check mandate encompasses diesel and alternative fuel trucks and buses with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) exceeding 14,000 pounds. This includes out-of-state, out-of-country vehicles, California motorhomes, and agricultural vehicles, all of which are obligated to:

- Undergo consistent testing to verify the optimal operation of all emissions-related equipment.
- Provide the testing data to CARB.
- Fulfill a yearly compliance fee of \$30 for each vehicle.

Timeline

January 2024

For legal operation in California:

- Adherence to NST letter requirements and reporting
- Fulfillment of compliance fee payments

Began January 2023

- Screening of high-emission vehicles utilizing roadside emissions monitoring
- Issuance of Notice to Submit to Testing (NST) for vehicles flagged as potential high emitters

Planned Start for July 2024

- Transition to periodic compliance testing
- Conclusion of the Periodic Smoke Inspection Program (PSIP)

Planned Start for October 2023

2023 Data Submission to Clean Truck Check Database System:

- Create owner accounts and input relevant owner/vehicle details
- Complete payment of per-vehicle compliance fees for 2023
